Burghound Score: 87-89	<p>A ripe but quite fresh nose freely offers up notes of various red berries that are cut with evident earth elements. The delicious and vibrant medium weight flavors possess very good depth and length on the crunchy finish for a wine of this level. To be sure, this is rustic but this is an excellent Bourgogne. Vinous Score: 85-87	<p>The 2018 Bourgogne Rouge had been sulfured the day prior to my visit in November. Raspberry and cranberry fruit on the nose. The medium-bodied palate offers spicy black currant and strawberry fruit and a peppery finish. Fine.</p> <p><i>-Neal Martin, Vinous.com</i></p>

Burghound Score: 89-91	<p>A slightly riper mix of dark currant, plum and freshly turned earth introduces very rich and attractively vibrant middle weight flavors that exude a subtle minerality on the youthfully austere finish. Vinous Score: 89-91	<p>The 2018 Gevrey-Chambertin Village has a very floral bouquet of pure red cherries and crushed strawberry fruit that blossoms in the glass. Burghound Score: 90-92	<p>Ripe, fresh and densely fruited aromas speak of various dark berries, earth and a whiff of forest floor. The notably finer middle weight flavors exude evident minerality before culminating in a seductively textured if notably firm finish where a touch of bitter cherry pit arises. Vinous Score: 91-93	<p>The 2018 Gevrey-Chambertin 1er Cru is the usual assemblage of vines in La Perrière and Crepiot. It has a slightly sullen bouquet at the moment, more introverted than the Gevrey Village. The palate is medium-bodied with fine-grained tannins. Burghound Score: 89-91	<p>This is aromatically similar to the En la Rue de Vergy though noticeably spicier. The racy, intense and attractively fresh medium-bodied flavors culminate in a saline, youthfully austere and impressively long finish. This very Chambollesque effort needs to develop a bit more depth but the underlying material appears to be present for that to occur in time.</p> <p>(&lt;40% of the blend is from four different lers, including La Combe d'Orveau)</p> <p>-Allen Meadows, <i>Burghound.com</i></p>

Burghound Score: 89-91	<p>Light reduction is enough to blur the nuance of the ripe dark berry fruit and sauvage scents. There is both excellent freshness and verve to the solidly powerful, indeed even robust, medium weight flavors that retain good focus on the detailed and lingering finish. Burghound Score: 88-91	<p>A slightly more deeply pitched nose features notes of black cherry, plum and a top note of pomegranate. The sleeker and more refined medium weight flavors exude a subtle minerality on the bitter cherry pit-inflected finale. Vinous Score: 90-92	<p>The 2018 Morey-Saint-Denis en la Rue de Vergy has a perfumed, floral bouquet, the 20% new oak nicely integrated. The palate is lovely, with supple fleshy tannins, copious red cherry and cranberry fruit and a touch of spice toward the pure, elegant finish. Burghound Score: 90-92	<p>Moderate reduction dominates the nose today though there is very good verve to the nicely dense and textured medium weight flavors that exhibit focused power on the dusty and youthfully austere if slightly awkward finish due to mildly grippy tannins. <p>Vinous Score: 92-94</p>	<p>The 2018 Morey-Saint-Denis La Riotte 1er Cru has a crisp, classically styled, crushed rock and slightly chalky bouquet, the tightly coiled red and black fruit overshadowed by that stony facade. The palate conveys a lot of nascent energy, offering bright red berries laced with blood orange and brown spices, and leading to a precise and very persistent finish. <p>Burghound Score: 91-94</p>	<p>There is a top note of menthol on the airy and cool aromas red and dark cherry, raspberry, spice and lovely floral nuances. The succulent and admirably concentrated medium weight flavors exude a bracing salinity on the impressively long finish. <p>Vinous Score: 92-94</p>	<p>The 2018 Chambolle-Musigny La Combe d'Orveau "Cuvée Ultra" has a more expressive and extroverted bouquet compared to its counterpart in Nuits Saint-Georges, featuring kirsch, orange peel and hints of brown spice. The palate is medium-bodied with fine tannins, a caressing texture and a touch of spice and white pepper toward the persistent finish. <p>Burghound Score: 91-93</p>	<p>There is plenty of savage character to the liqueur-like aromas features notes of red and dark currant along with pretty floral nuances. <p>Vinous Score: 91-93</p>	<p>The 2018 Charmes-Chambertin Grand Cru has a surprisingly reserved bouquet for this vineyard, featuring tightly coiled, slightly earthy dark fruit laced with subtle brine-like aromas. <p>Burghound Score: 92-94</p>	<p>Once again the nose is strikingly floral though with plenty of savage character suffusing the fresh mix of red and dark currant, earth and forest floor. The racy, intense and appealingly delineated larger-scaled flavors possess focused power on the balanced, clean and beautifully long finish. <p>Vinous Score: 96-98</p>	<p>The 2018 Mazoyères-Chambertin Vieilles Vignes Grand Cru has a complex bouquet of pure brambly black fruit, crushed stone, undergrowth and subtle hints of cassis and violet that emerge with time. This is quite mercurial in the glass. The palate is medium-bodied with very fine tannins, wonderfully pitched acidity and a sense of harmony and precision that renders this perhaps the more graceful of the Mazoyères-Chambertins that Perrot-Minot has produced. <p>Burghound Score: 89-92</p>	<p>A beautifully layered nose combines notes of red and black cherry with those of rose petal, violet, lavender and a range of spice elements. There is very good mid-palate density to the attractively, even seductively, textured flavors that flash a lovely minerality on the dusty, youthfully austere and impressively complex and lengthy finish for a villages level wine. <p>Vinous Score: 88-90</p>	<p>The 2018 Vosne-Romanée Les Champs Perdrix feels a little muted on the nose compared to its peers, despite rigorous coaxing. The palate is medium-bodied with fine tannins, a slightly powdery texture and a short, compact finish. <p>Burghound Score: 90-92</p>	<p>Aromas of wild dark berries cherry, forest floor and earth complement the sleek, intense and muscular middle weight plus flavors that possess fine depth and sneaky good length. <p>Vinous Score: 91-93</p>	<p>The 2018 Nuits Saint-Georges Les Murgers des Cras is a mélange of three Premier Crus: Cras, Les Murgers and Richemone. It has a precise, focused bouquet of brambly black fruit with light sous-bois elements emerging, followed later by powdered chalk. The palate is medium-bodied with fine-grained tannins, good weight and precision, a fine bead of acidity and a classy, minerally finish. Excellent.</p> <p><i>-Neal Martin, Vinous.com</i></p>

<p>Burghound Score: 91-94</p>	<p>Here too the animated nose is prominently spicy with its array of poached plum, violet, rose petal and sandalwood aromas. <p>Vinous Score: 93-95</p>	<p>The 2018 Nuit-Saint-Georges La Richemone Vieilles Vignes "Cuvée Ultra" has a complex bouquet that combines red and black fruit, brown spices, sea cave and light oyster shell aromas, all very well delineated. The palate is defined by svelte and supple tannins, finely pitched acidity and a very elegant and disarmingly pure and persistent finish. The palate impression of the tension and mineral-inflected middle weight flavors is every bit as refined as that of the Fuées while the chiseled, linear and pure finish delivers very fine length and depth. <p>Vinous Score: 90-92</p>	<p>The 2018 Vosne-Romanée Les Beaux Monts Vieilles Vignes 1er Cru offers black fruit, black truffle and undergrowth aromas on the nose. There is a slight touch of dried apricot in the background. The palate is medium-bodied with supple tannins matched by fine acidity. The suave, round and seductively textured lager-scaled flavors possess a sleek muscularity and good minerality while delivering outstanding depth and length on the velvety and sappy finish. <p>Vinous Score: 93-95</p>	<p>The 2018 Chapelle-Chambertin Grand Cru has a much bolder and more expressive nose compared to the Charmes-Chambertin, offering copious blackberry, raspberry and crushed chalk aromas that burst from the glass. The palate is medium-bodied with supple tannin and a fine bead of acidity. Harmonious right to the end, delivering more depth and substance than the Charmes-Chambertin. <p>Burghound Score: 93-95</p>	<p>A slightly riper and definitely more expressive nose of cassis, poached plum and violet are decidedly spicy. <p>Vinous Score: 96-98</p>	<p>The 2018 Chambertin Clos-de-Bèze Grand Cru has a supremely well-defined, stony, intense bouquet that is just as detailed as the Chambertin, if not more so. This has fathomless depth. The palate is medium-bodied with very fine tannins, taut and linear at first then fanning out beautifully toward the finish. <p>Burghound Score: 93-95</p>	<p>In contrast to the exuberance of many of the wines, here the nose is all but mute and requires aggressive swirling to coax the timid aromas of softly spicy and decidedly cool aromas of red and black currant, humus-tinged earth and plenty of floral nuances. The racy, tight and almost painfully intense big-bodied and muscular flavors also exhibit an abundance of minerality that adds lift to the compact, linear and subtly persistent finish. <p>Vinous Score: 95-97</p>	<p>The 2018 Chambertin Grand Cru has a regal, complex and quite compelling bouquet of layers of black fruit laced with black truffle, woodland and light leafy aromas. There is superb intensity here. The medium-bodied palate delivers fine-grained tannins. Very precise and elegant, with tangible mineralité and great tension on the finish. <p>Burghound Score: 87-90</p>	<p>A very ripe liqueur-like nose speaks primarily of various dark berries and spice wisps. The rich, full-bodied and succulent flavors remain reasonably well-balanced on the lingering finale though there is a mild touch of backend warmth.</p> <p><i>-Allen Meadows, Burghound.com</i></p>

<p>Burghound Score: 88-91</p>	<p>This is aromatically more elegant and a bit cooler as well though it is still notably ripe with its array of essence of red cherry, pomegranate and nicely broad range of spice elements. Burghound Score: 90-92	As is usually the case, this is the spiciest wine in the range with its equally liqueur-like nose of poached plum, cassis and violet. The very generously proportioned middle weight flavors exude a discreet minerality on the clean, dry and lingering finish that exhibits just enough warmth to notice. This isn't as elegant as it typically is though it is certainly richer.  <i>-Allen Meadows, Burghound.com</i>

Burghound Score: 90-93	Discreet but not invisible wood sets off the more deeply pitched aromas of menthol, cassis and once again plum liqueur. Burghound Score: 89-91	A more elegant nose is comprised by notes of the fresh and airy essence of red and dark cherry, violet and soft spice wisps. Here too there is very good vibrancy to the lilted and well-detailed medium weight flavors that flash evident salinity on the focused, balanced and sneaky long finale. Vinous Score: 90-92	The 2018 Chambolle-Musigny Village has a very harmonious, slightly earthy bouquet, the 100% whole bunch lending a very discreet tertiary/sous-bois quality. The palate is medium-bodied with crunchy red fruit (cranberry, strawberry and pomegranate). This has quite strict tannins and a Morey-inspired, sapid finish. Burghound Score: 88-90	<p>A discreet but not invisible application of wood can be found on the fresh mix of red and dark pinot fruit, earth, spice and overt floral nuances. This is not especially dense but I like the energy of the middle weight flavors that possess a highly attractive texture, all wrapped in a firm, nicely complex and only mildly rustic finale.</p> <p><i>-Allen Meadows, Burghound.com</i></p>				
Vinous Score: 89-91	<p>The 2018 Nuits Saint-Georges Village has a very pure bouquet of raspberry, wild strawberry and hints of blue fruit; pressed violets emerge with time. The palate is medium-bodied with fine-grained tannins, and quite firm, offering a mixture of red and black fruits laced with truffle and cedar toward the finish. Vinous Score: 88-90	<p>The 2018 Nuit Saint-Georges Les Poisets comes from 0.7 hectares that this year produced just five barrels due to hail (14hl/ha). The nose feels a little disjointed at the moment, missing the focus that imbues Lachaux's other 2018s. It needs to find more harmony during its élevage. Burghound Score: 90-92	<p>This too is quite firmly reduced and aromatically unreadable at present. Vinous Score: 90-92	<p>The 2018 Nuits Saint-Georges Les Procès has a complex bouquet featuring earthy and woodland aromas and touches of morels and black truffle. The palate is medium-bodied with slightly chalky tannins, and more compact than the Les Poisets, showing a touch of black pepper on the finish. Burghound Score: 89-91	<p>A strikingly pretty nose layers cool red berry fruit aromas with those of earth and plenty of floral influences. There is both good tension and an attractive mouthfeel to the delicious flavors that also lean out slightly on the otherwise solidly persistent finish.</p> <p><i>-Allen Meadows, Burghound.com</i></p>				
Vinous Score: 91-93	<p>The 2018 Nuits Saint-Georges Les Corvées Pagets 1er Cru comprises four barrels after being severely affected by hail. It has a rather stoic bouquet of introspective dark berry fruit mixed with black tea and damp earthy aromas. The medium-bodied palate delivers precise, filigreed tannins. That black tea element crops up again in the mouth, segueing into a subtle, brine-tinged finish that fans out gently. Burghound Score: 89-92	<p>This too is quite elegant though with a different aromatic profile that derives more from the darker side of the fruit spectrum while incorporating a wide array of floral and spice elements. The suave, refined and sappy medium-bodied flavors possess a beguiling texture before culminating in a beautifully long and well-balanced finish. Vinous Score: 88-90	<p>The 2018 Vosne-Romanée Village perhaps shows the whole-bunch influence more than the other Village Crus, to the point where I might have de-stemmed some bunches. The palate is fresh and crisp on the entry, with fine tannins, and here the whole bunch is better integrated. A saline, marine-influenced finish lingers in the mouth. Burghound Score: 90-92	<p>An exuberantly spicy nose freely offers up aromas of violet, poached plum and dark cherry along with a lovely hint of orange pekoe tea. The succulent and suave medium-bodied flavors brim with dry extract before terminating in a powerful, punchy and palate coating if mildly rustic finish.
